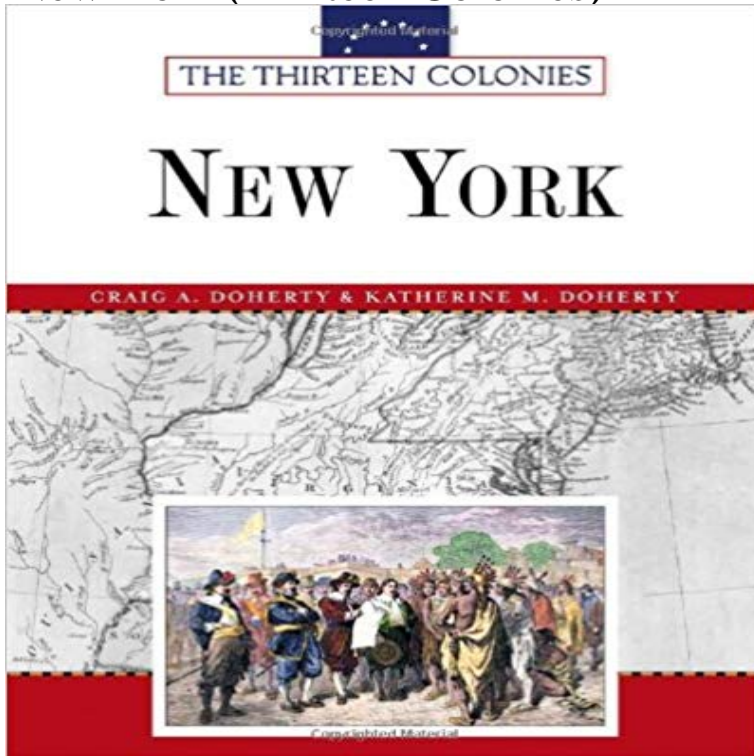


New York (Thirteen Colonies)
