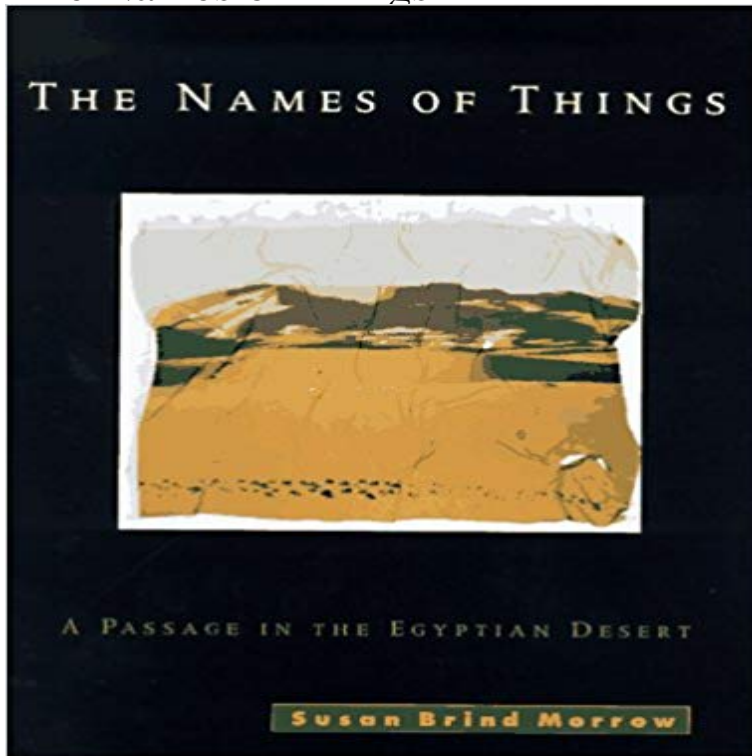


The Names of Things
